The renovation of the Pilgrim Arena has started...

The renovation of the pilgrim arena has started earlier than planned. The pilgrim arena is one of three central spots for the Schoenstatt jubilee pilgrimage. This is where all pilgrims will come together and where all four main events, which will also be transmitted live, will take place. After reconstruction of the arena in 1984/85 the pilgrim arena was able to hold a maximal capacity of 12,000 people. The approved building company for the reconstruction has begun with an enhancement of the area and the addition of terraces. The benches will be renewed or replaced at a later date. All electric wiring and drainage will be renewed during the renovations.
